#### CCWC Health and Wellness Committee...

organizes food drives, clothing drives, and school supplies collections, as needs arise for various community organizations throughout the year.

- Each month CCWC members volunteer at *Food for Others*, a local food bank serving the Fairfax area. Our members assemble 12 nutritional food items in "Power Packs" that are distributed to children in 43 participating elementary schools in Fairfax County, to supplement meals for students over the weekend. Over 3500 Power Packs are distributed to those schools each week.
- Each November CCWC does a food collection. This year we donated over \$800 in food and cash to *ECHO*, a food bank serving the Springfield community.
- In December, we supported *The Lamb Center*, a shelter serving the neighborhood homeless, with a donation of over \$700 of much needed warm socks and clothing.

#### CCWC and The Lamb Center ...

Clifton Community Woman's Club has been providing hot lunches once a month since 2018 for The Lamb Center, a daytime, drop-in shelter for the poor and homeless in Fairfax, Virginia. CCWC was determined to continue its support during the pandemic, so we began providing a variety of sandwiches made by our members along with fruits and veggies, chips, desserts, and drinks.
